The “Medium” and “Large” divisions may be combined to yield one “Large” division, as well. Division splitting and/or combining is done to promote competition.

Junior Varsity Coed	12 <sup>th</sup> grade & below	Female/Male	5-35 members	
*JH Divisions Guidelines: 9 <sup>th</sup> grade participants are only allowed if the 9 <sup>th</sup> grade class is housed in the school you are representing and only a minority of the team are 9 <sup>th</sup> graders. If a majority of the team are 9 <sup>th</sup> graders then the team should compete in the JV division.

*Varsity	12 <sup>th</sup> grade & below	Female	5-35 Members	
Small Varsity Coed	12 <sup>th</sup> grade & below	Female/Male	5-35 Members	Only 1-4 males allowed.
Large Varsity Coed	12 <sup>th</sup> grade & below	Female/Male	5-35 Members	5 or more males allowed.
<b>Non-Building Varsity Divisions</b>				
Junior Non-Building	JR or JV Team	Female/Male	5-35 Members	No partner stunts, pyramids, or tosses allowed.
*Varsity Non-Building	12 <sup>th</sup> grade & below	Female/Male	5-35 Members	
<b>Non-Tumbling Divisions</b>				
All tumbling is prohibited, except for inversions into load-in positions, stunts, and pyramids. Tumbling is defined as any skill with feet over head rotation.				
Junior Non-Tumbling	Jr or JV Team	Female/Male	5-35 Members	No tumbling skills allowed.
*Varsity Non-Tumbling	12 <sup>th</sup> grade & below	Female	5-35 Members	
<b>Recreational League Divisions</b>				
* The following divisions will follow standard safety guidelines.				
For teams whose main purpose is cheering for and supporting a recreational sports team (i.e. youth football, pee wee sports, community sports teams, etc.) Competitive only youth programs are considered All Stars and must register as such, and follow USASF guidelines.
